

Is your child two years old?

The integrated review for two-year-olds

The **Integrated Review** is a joint check-up that takes place when your child is around **two to two-three years of age**. It brings together information from both **health** and **early years education** (such as nursery or childminder) to give a full picture of your child's development.

A member of the Essex Child and Family Wellbeing Service Healthy Family Team will contact you to carry out the **Health and Development Review** on children two to three years of age. The **Early Years Foundation Stage Progress Check** is completed by your key person in your child's early years setting at age two to three years.

What does this mean for you and your child? The joint check will build a more complete picture of your child's progress and achievements at this crucial stage in their development.

You will be encouraged to share your knowledge and views about your child and actively contribute to the review.

The review will combine:

- ❖ Parents' views and knowledge about their child's progress
- ❖ The early years practitioner's detailed knowledge of how the child is learning and developing based on day-to-day observation in their educational setting
- ❖ The Essex Child and Family Wellbeing Service Healthy Family Teams expertise in the health and development of young children
