Main changes across both sets of guidance

- Guidance amended to extend its applicability into the autumn school term, and reflect that state schools have now closed for the summer holidays
- Set out a change to the protective measures which will be effective from the point at
 which all pupils return to school in the autumn, making clear the position on group sizes
 and how providers can minimise the risk of children mixing outside their school bubbles
- Added additional content on shared resources.
