

Is your child two years old?

The integrated review for two year olds

Local authorities, health visiting services and early years providers are now combining the Early Years Foundation Stage Progress Check with the Healthy Child Programme and Ages and Stages Development Review.

A member of the health visiting team will contact you to carry out the Healthy Child Programme Review on children aged two to two-and-a-half years. The Early Years Foundation Stage Progress Check is completed by your key person in your child's early years setting at age two to three years.

What does this mean for you and your child? The new combined reviews will build a more complete picture of your child's progress and achievements at this crucial stage in their development.

You will be encouraged to share your knowledge and views about your child and actively contribute to the review.

The review will combine:

- Parents' views and knowledge about their child's progress
- The early years practitioner's detailed knowledge of how the child is learning and developing based on day to day observation in their educational setting
- The health visitor's expertise in the health and development of young children
